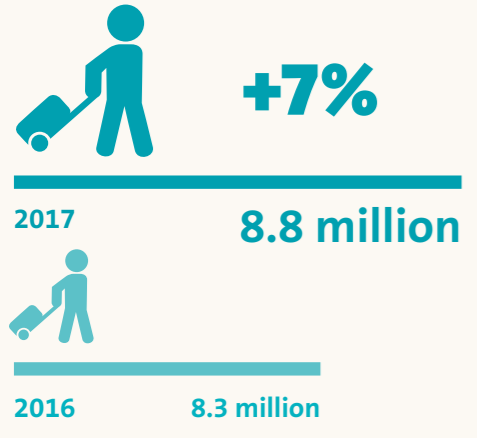


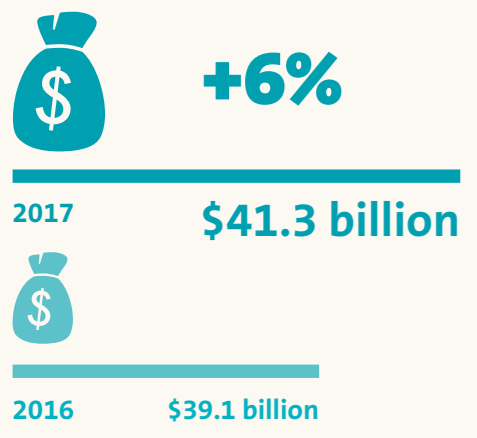
International Tourism Snapshot as at 31 December 2017

We welcomed 8.8 million international visitors as at year ending December 2017. These visitors injected \$41.3 billion into the Australian economy. Total international aviation capacity to Australia grew by 5 per cent.

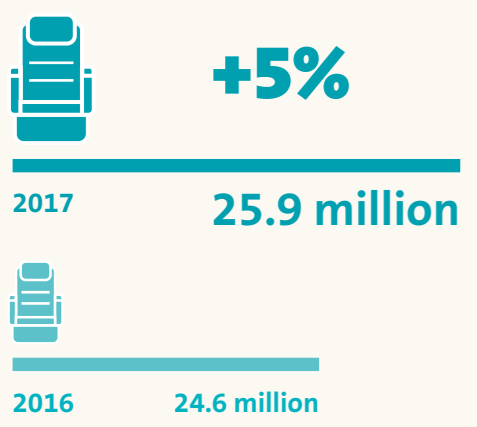
Total international arrivals to Australia



Total international visitor spend

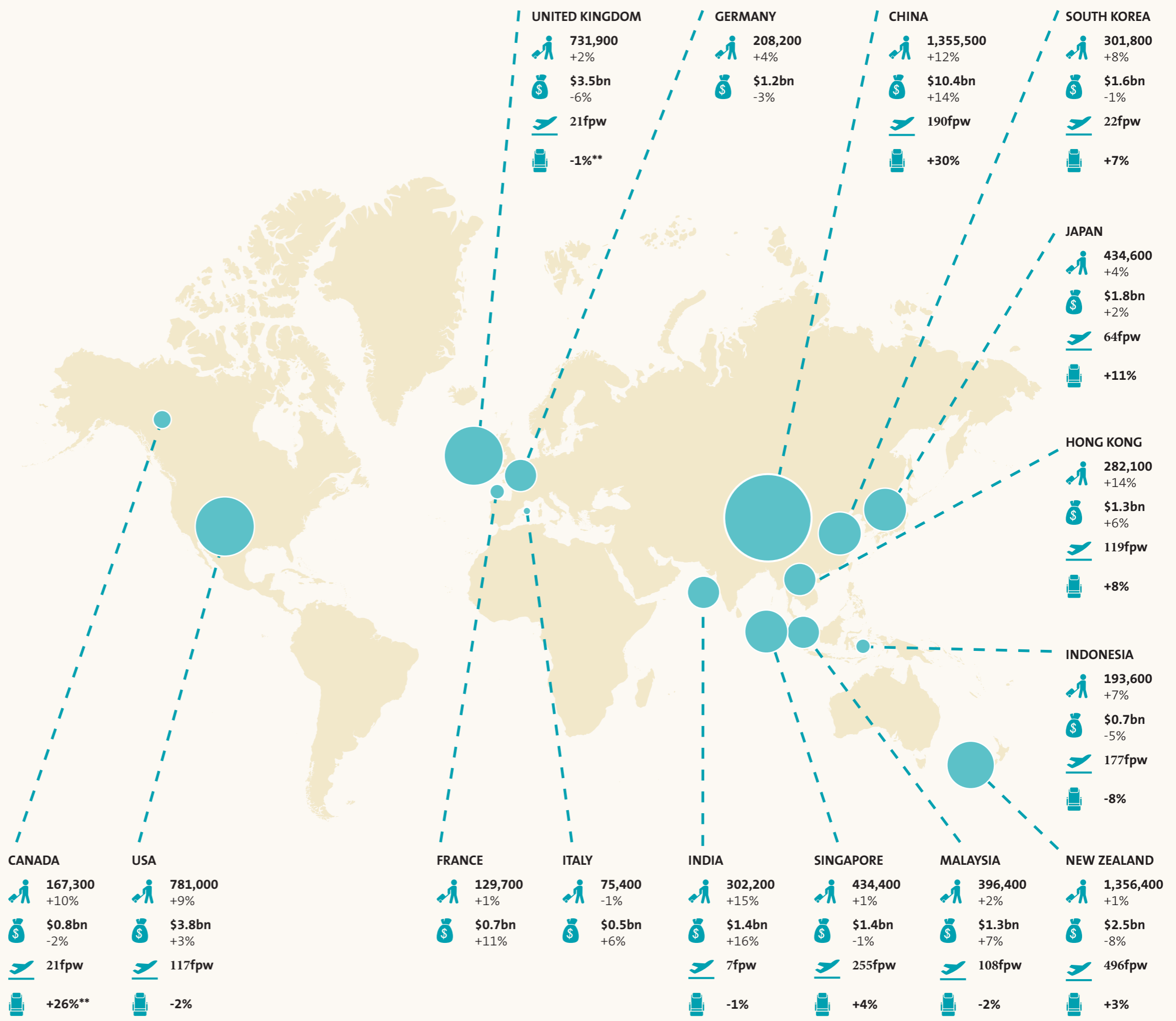


Total international aviation capacity* (inbound seats)
