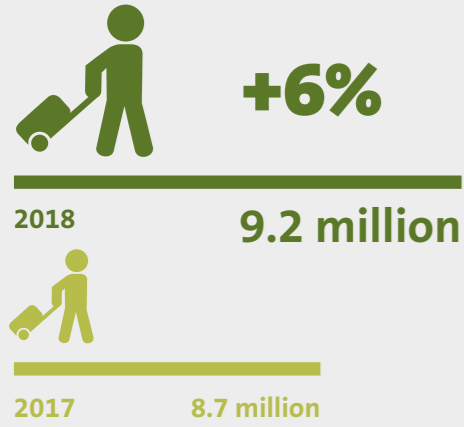


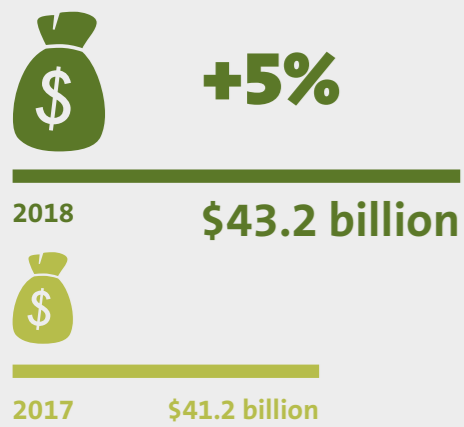
# International Tourism Snapshot as at 30 September 2018

We welcomed 9.2 million international visitors as at year ending September 2018. These visitors injected \$43.2 billion into the Australian economy. Total international aviation capacity to Australia grew by 4 per cent.

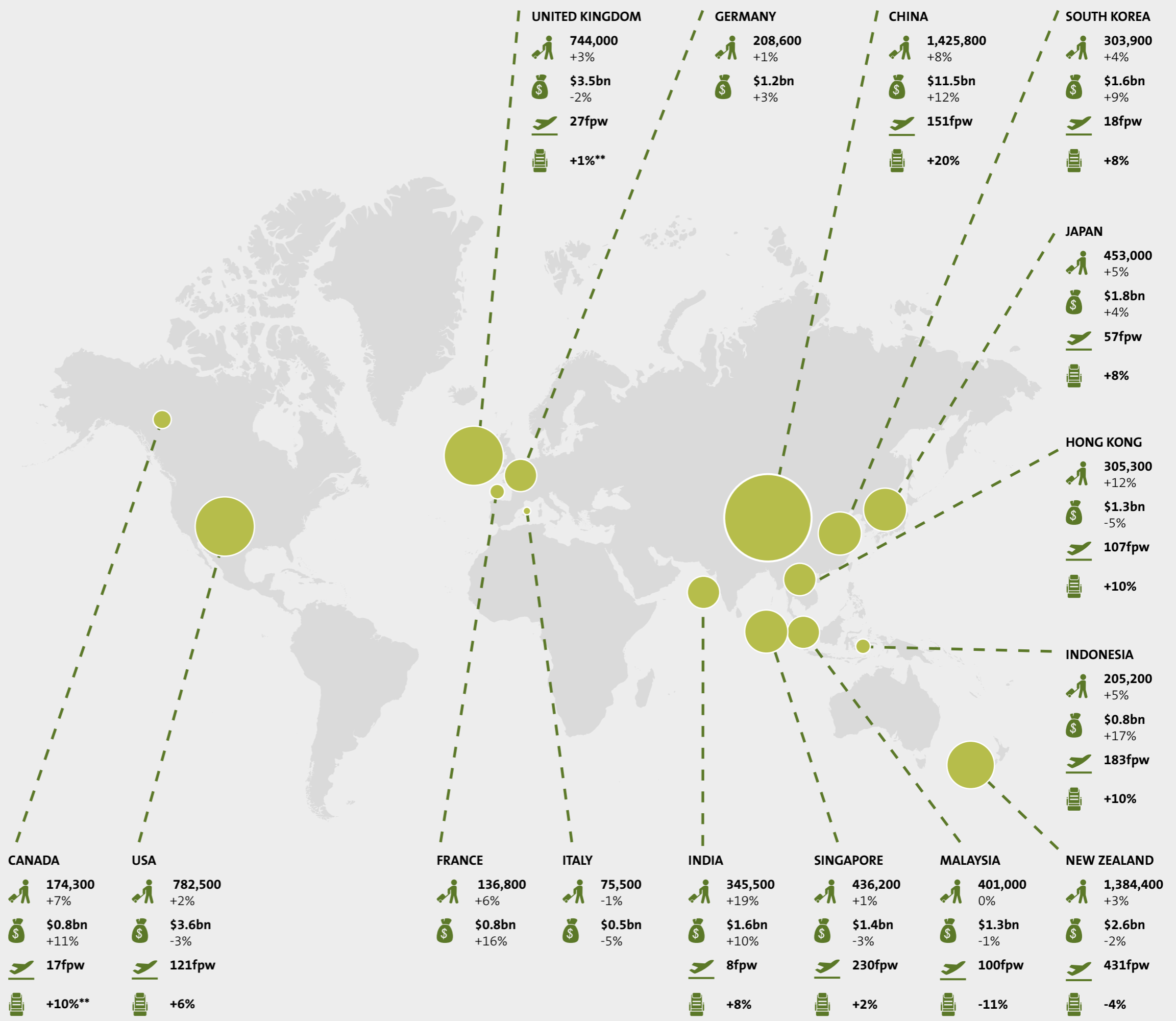
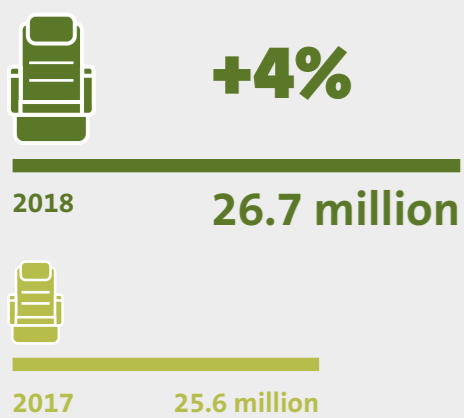
## Total international arrivals to Australia
